## Volunteer opportunities:

**Lifting and dumping items into dumpsters** - need several people (the more the better!)

**Separating scrap metal from regular debris** - proceeds from metal taken to recycle will be put in the park fund.

**Truck & Trailer-** need several-these volunteers will drive around to assist with gathering/ pickup of debris and bring to the dumpsters. Anyone who provides a truck and trailer will be givenive a \$25 gas gift card to help with gasoline expense!

To ensure we have enough people for this event to be successful, as well as to have enough equipment, refreshments, etc., residents are encouraged to **register to volunteer in advance by calling the QCMUD at 361-572-0810.** Volunteers ages 12 and up are welcome; **children must be accompanied by an adult.** Great opportunity for students needing service hours!

We realize things can change and you may not be able to sign up now or have to cancel. Walk-up volunteers are always welcome!!

On clean-up day (Oct. 12), residents and volunteers will be treated to breakfast sausage kolaches, donuts, coffee and juice at the check in spot by the ball fields on Chukar beginning at **7:30 am**.

**8:00 am** will split into teams and begin work. Safety vests and gloves will be provided. Water and Gatorade will be available for volunteers throughout the day.

## PLEASE READ FOLLOWING CAREFULLY:

Residents are encouraged to bring items for disposal to the dumpsters from 8:00 am-5:00 pm. Only items approved by White Trash Services are acceptable. (see list of unacceptable materials). Metal will be collected in a separate pile and taken to recycle with proceeds going towards the park fund.

Place items INSIDE the dumpsters – DO NOT leave items on the ground!

**IMPORTANT:** IF we have enough volunteers AND IF arrangements are set up by October 4. Any resident who can gather items for disposal, but cannot take to the dumpster OR any resident who needs help gathering debris and transporting to the dumpster site, help is possible, IF we have enough volunteers, AND IF arrangements are set up by October 4.

**VERY IMPORTANT:** Residents that need assistance MUST contact the Quail Creek Homeowners' Association at 361-648-0711 by October 4, to provide details of help needed, to register their request and provide their address. Items WILL NOT be picked up if advanced arrangements have not been made. **DO NOT** put items for disposal at the curb WITHOUT having an address registered for pick up assistance!
